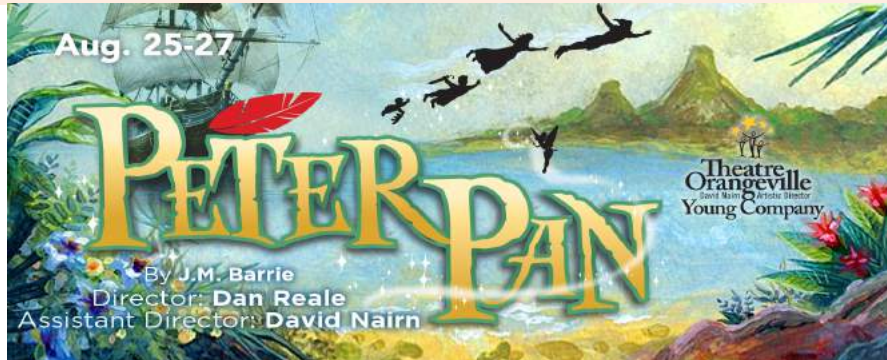

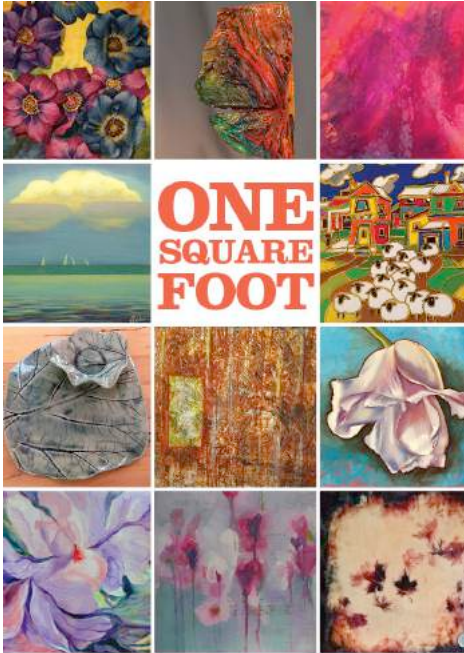
Reed T Cooper Bursary in Visual Arts

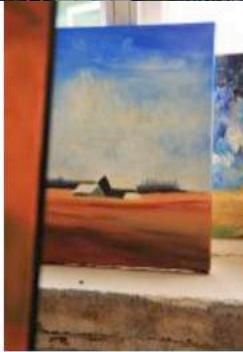
