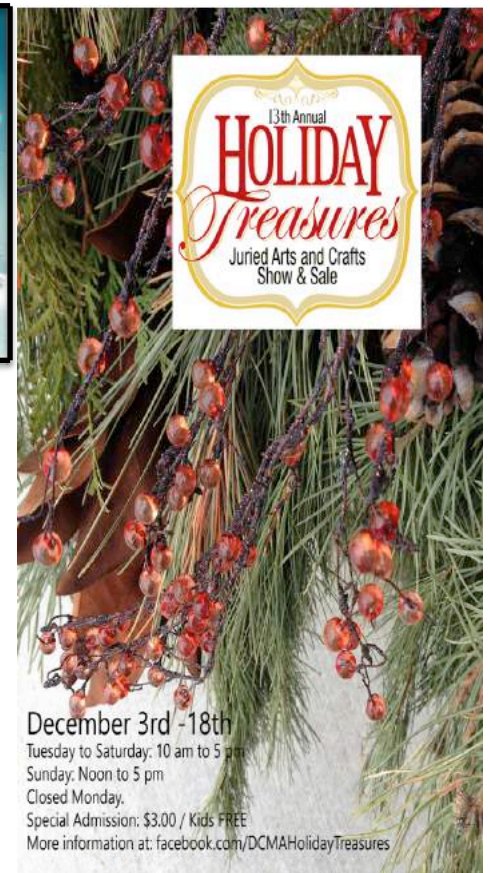
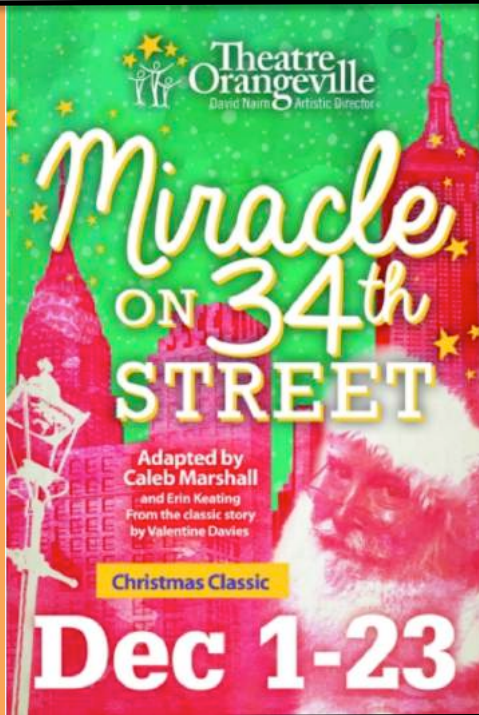

In this workshop, Tony will review some of the steps in the planning process such as: What is your concept for the painting? What are some compositional considerations?
