The Theatre Group: The Caledon Townhall Players (CTHP) had their first performance of "Angels Unawares" in June 1962 in the Old Townhall, in the Village of Caledon. Subsequently, a series of short-term leases to continue use of the building were drawn up between CTHP and the Town of Caledon, and they have been presenting live theatre productions in that venue ever since. On Feb 20th, 1985, a 20 year lease was signed, and it in turn was renewed for a further 20 years commencing Dec 31st, 2004. They celebrated their 50th Season in 2013-2014.
