Wednesday, September 19 - October 8, 2018

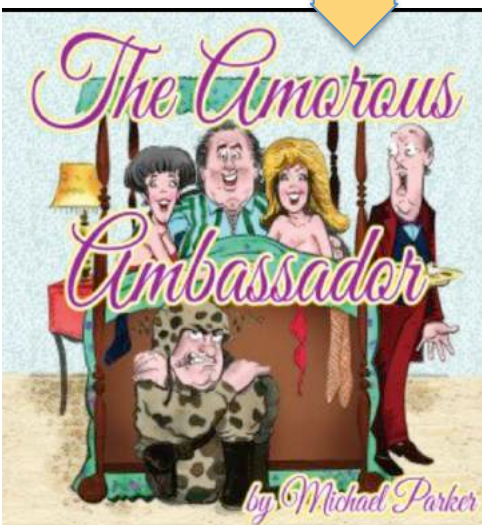
