OAG Workshops:

DRAWING THE HUMAN FACE WITH DAVID CHESTERTON

Have you ever tried to draw a portrait of someone special to you, a family member, an ancestor, a friend or anyone else that you wish to create an image of? Only to find that it is much harder to do than you thought. In this workshop you will learn that there are proportions and dimensions to the human face structure that are predictable and measurable. Learning these and drawing using them will get you off to a solid start to creating a portrait that has the "likeness" you are looking for. In this workshop you will be drawing a portrait from a live model to put into practice these techniques, so that you can apply them, with coaching assistance right away. David Chesterton enjoys both watercolour painting and brush and ink illustration and has been writing stories since childhood. He sold his first watercolour painting at a fair in Ilkeston, England, when he was nine years old, and had his first story published in a school magazine when he was twelve. He comes by his painting ability naturally as both parents were watercolorists, but he added to their training with studies at the College of Art and Technology at the University for Leicester. David has a collection of portraits of famous actors and actresses from his life in Hollywood and he continues to do portraits of his family, notably grandchildren.
